

The fee for the passport is payable in local currency at the time of application. Where the new passport is to be sent to you by post, please send the appropriate postal charges (including registered post fee) with the remittance. Citizens of another Commonwealth country should apply to the nearest representative of the Commonwealth country concerned.

Dual nationality: if you possess the nationality or citizenship of another country, you may lose this when you get a British passport. Please check with the authorities of the other country before making your application.

DO NOT USE THIS FORM if you are a British National (Overseas) having a close connection with Hong Kong - use form BNO-A*.

How long does it take to get a passport?

Wherever possible, please submit the application, whether by post or in person, at least 4 weeks before you need the passport.
