Elevation range: 35 to 150 feet    Slope range: 0% to 3%

### RANGE SITE DESCRIPTION

This site consists of a mixture of hardwood tree species such as Hophornbean, Hawthorns, Dogwoods, Magnolia, Hickory, Maple, Gum, Live Oak, Laurel Oak, and Water Oak. The tree canopy can become excessive on this site drastically reduce forage quality and quantity. In excellent range condition Indiangrass, Switchgrass, Longleaf Uniola, Purpletop, and several Bluestem Species will provide most of the important forage production.
