

STATEMENT OF WORK

These deliverables apply to this individual practice. For other planned practice deliverables refer to those specific Statements of Work.

DESIGN

Deliverables:

1. Design documents that demonstrate criteria in NRCS practice standard have been met and are compatible with planned and applied practices.
 - a. Practice purpose(s) as identified in the conservation plan
 - b. List of required permits to be obtained by the client
 - c. Practice standard criteria-related computations and analyses to develop plans and specifications including but not limited to:
 - i. Condition, amount and extent of residual slash
 - ii. Slash treatment method (i.e. burning, chipping, lop and scatter, removal, crushing)
 - iii. Timing of treatment
 - iv. Special requirements for identified additional practice standard criteria
2. Written plans and specifications including sketches and drawings shall be provided to the client to adequately describe the requirements to install the practice and obtain necessary permits.
3. Documentation of needed operation and maintenance.
4. Certification that the design meets practice standard criteria and comply with applicable laws and regulations.
5. Design modifications during installation as required.

INSTALLATION

Deliverables

1. Pre-application conference with client.
2. Verification that client has obtained required permits.
3. Layout and applicable layout notes.
4. Application guidance as needed.
5. Facilitate and implement required design modifications with client and original designer.
6. Advise client/NRCS on compliance issues with all federal, state, tribal, and local laws, regulations and NRCS policies during installation.
7. Certification that the application process and materials meet design and permit requirements.

CHECK OUT

Deliverables / Practice Certification and Check-out Requirements

1. Records of application for certification:
 - a. Objective of forest slash treatment(s)
 - b. Schedule and methods of treatment
 - c. Plans for management/disposal of debris
 - d. Brush piles:
 - i. Locations
 - ii. Dimensions
 - iii. Estimated fuel load (if planning prescribed burning)
2. Certification that the application meets NRCS standards and specifications and is in compliance with permits.
3. Progress reporting.
