



**THREATENED AND ENDANGERED SPECIES:  
AVIAN NESTING ZONE TABLE**

<b>Species</b>	<b>Nesting Zone</b>	<b>Nesting Period</b>
Audubon's Crested Caracara	1000 ft. buffer from active nest tree	November-April
Bald Eagle	660 ft. buffer from active nest tree	October 1 – May 15
Everglades Snail Kite	1,640 ft. buffer from active nest trees	January - May
Florida Scrub Jay	150 ft. buffer from active nest tree	March - June
Red-cockaded Woodpecker	200 ft. buffer from cluster*	April 1 <sup>st</sup> - July 31 <sup>st</sup>
Woodstork	1,000 ft. buffer from nesting colony	South FL: January-June North and Central FL: March-August

\* A cluster is defined as the minimum convex polygon containing the aggregation of cavity trees both (active and inactive) used by a group of RCW.
