122	<b>Agricultural Energy Conservation Activity Plan - Headquarters - Livestock</b>	Services provided by a certified Technical Service Provider (TSP) involving the development of an energy audit on animal feeding operations including swine, poultry and dairy facilities. The energy audit, or AgEMP Conservation Activity Plan (CAP) involves a producer interview and data collection on existing energy consumption such as lighting, ventilation, etc. and provides suggestions for efficiency upgrades within the infrastructure that will result in maximizing energy efficiency. The AgEMP CAP shall comply with federal, state, tribal and local laws, regulations and permit requirements.
122	<b>Agricultural Energy Conservation Activity Plan - Headquarters - Non-Livestock</b>	Services provided by a certified Technical Service Provider (TSP) involving the development of an energy audit on non-livestock crop farm operations which may include processing areas. The energy audit, or AgEMP Conservation Activity Plan (CAP) involves a producer interview and data collection on existing energy consumption such as lighting, ventilation, etc. and provides suggestions for efficiency upgrades within the infrastructure that will result in maximizing energy efficiency. The AgEMP CAP shall comply with federal, state, tribal and local laws, regulations and permit requirements.
122	<b>Agricultural Energy Conservation Activity Plan - Landscape - Irrigated</b>	Services provided by a certified Technical Service Provider (TSP) involving the development of an energy audit on the landscape including cropland. The energy audit, or AgEMP Conservation Activity Plan (CAP) involves data collection on existing energy consumption of irrigation systems including system type, system pressure, irrigation water management techniques, pumping plant evaluation and system maintenance and provides suggestions that will result in maximizing energy efficiency. The AgEMP CAP shall comply with federal, state, tribal and local laws, regulations and permit requirements.
122	<b>Agricultural Energy Conservation Activity Plan - Landscape - Non-Irrigated</b>	Services provided by a certified Technical Service Provider (TSP) involving the development of an energy audit on the landscape including cropland. The energy audit, or AgEMP Conservation Activity Plan (CAP) involves data collection on existing energy consumption such and field equipment operations (tillage), pasture management (grazing, water/feed vs. watering facility development), forest management/harvest (trails/landings, equipment use) and provides suggestions that will result in maximizing energy efficiency. The AgEMP CAP shall comply with federal, state, tribal and local laws, regulations and permit requirements.
