SECTION III

Section III Table of Contents – This table has been updated to reflect new information being provided.

Part D, Conservation System Guides & Conservation Systems – This new part to Section III describes conservation system guides and conservation systems, their use, importance, naming conventions and how field level conservation planners can request new or modifications to existing guides and systems.

Filing Instructions

SECTION IV

Section IV Table of Contents – New table contents for Section is provided that includes all new additions associated with this Change Notice.

Amendments for the Treatment of Agricultural Waste (Code 591) - This new standard is intended to address the use of amendments to manure and other agricultural wastes for specific purposes such as odor reduction, ammonia emissions reduction, reduction of soluble phosphorus, etc. It applies to amendments used in any portion of the waste stream, including the production and storage facilities. It is not applicable to feed amendments.

Streambank and Shoreline Protection (Code 580) – Minor changes were made to this standard to reflect the changes made in the updated national standard.

Use Exclusion (Code 472) – This is a new practice standard that has been prepared for use in Florida. Please discontinue use of the National Standard and refer to this state standard when areas are in need of use exclusion from animals, humans or vehicles.

Waste Treatment (Code 629) – This new standard is intended to address the installation of alternative animal waste treatment systems and processes. It is intended to be broad enough to allow installation of a wide range of systems while providing sufficient criteria to ensure successful installation and operation.
