OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE ITEMS

The life of this practice can be assured and usually increased by developing and carrying out a systematic operation and maintenance program. Operation and Maintenance (O & M) is necessary for all conservation practices and is required for all practices installed with NRCS assistance. The land user is responsible for proper O & M throughout the life of the practice, generally 10 years, and as may be required by federal, state, or local laws or regulations.

This practice will require periodic maintenance and may also require operational items to maintain satisfactory performance. Your operation and maintenance program requirements include:

- Periodically check to ensure the site remains stable after the obstruction removal.
- Periodically check to ensure the disposal site, if disposal occurs on site, remains stable.
- Repair any problems as soon as possible.
