The traditional final product of first generation soil survey mapping has been the soil survey publication. Each publication included soil map unit descriptions, series descriptions, tables of information (attributes), and maps.

The soil survey of Hart County was published in 1963.

The official copy of the soil maps for this survey is the published soil survey in the local NRCS field office.

The official source of soils data (attributes) for this soil survey area is the National Soils Information System (NASIS) database as delivered through the [Soil Data Mart](#).
