Technical Reference Material List

This section contains subject lists of references that will be maintained in the field office. Local resource references will be acquired or developed and filed with other FOTG references. Especially important would be local information on water quality, threatened/endangered species, cultural resources, climate, agronomic practices, costs, laws, ordinances, and regulations.

Local references will be listed on the List of Local References. Precede each local reference number with an "L" (i.e., L1, L2, L3, etc.) to distinguish them from statewide references. If desired, these references may also be added to appropriate Subject Lists or cross-referenced in other subsections.
