**No Offsite Wetland Mapping Conventions
for the Pacific Islands Area**

The NRCS Director of the Pacific Islands Area (PI) has determined that wetland mapping conventions used as a guide for using offsite tools to make wetland determinations and delineations for the PI fail to meet regulatory requirements, and that all certified determinations will be completed onsite. Thus, no offsite wetland mapping conventions are posted in the PI electronic Field Office Technical Guide (eFOTG).

The Pacific Islands Area includes the State of Hawaii, Territory of American Samoa, Territory of Guam, Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, Republic of Palau, and Republic of the Marshall Islands.
