**AMENDMENT NO. 1**

A correlation amendment needs to be added to the "Classification and Correlation of the Soils in Calhoun County, Illinois" document issued in January, 1986. These corrections are needed for SSURGO certification.

In the legend of Approved map unit names, page 4, change the publication symbol and approved name of the following map unit:

From: 504G Sogn flaggy silt loam, 30 to 65 percent slopes

To: 403G Elizabeth flaggy silt loam, 30 to 65 percent slopes

In the legend of Approved map unit names, page 4, add field symbol, field name, publication symbol and approved name for the following map unit: (this change was previously covered by blanked SSURGO Amendment for all Illinois counties without the map unit on the correlated legend)

W |Water

To the Conversion Legend, page 9, make appropriate changes as indicated by the above changes in publication symbols.

To the Alphabetical list of soil map units, pages 10 and 11, make the appropriate changes to Publication Symbol and Approved Map Unit Name

To the Classification of the Soils, page 18, delete the Sogn Series and add the following:

Soil name            Family or higher taxonomic class

Elizabeth                    Loamy-skeletal, mixed, superactive, mesic Lithic Hapludolls
