



AMENDMENT NO. 2

A correlation amendment needs to be added to the "Classification and Correlation of Soils in Champaign County, Illinois" document issued in February 1999. The corrections needed are as follows:

On page 10 and on the folded page of Conventional and special symbols legend, streams are not classified as perennial or intermittent. Single streams and drainage and/or irrigation ditches are compiled as unclassified and will not be designated as perennial or intermittent.

On page 10, dams (medium or small) will not be shown.

On page 20, Martinsville series - new pedon selected; delete pedon number (77IL-019-014; previously 77IL-10-14) and change to pedon number (99IL-019-001).

On page 21, delete taxadjunct statement under Proctor series.

On page 22, Sawmill series - the typical pedon for the subset taxonomic unit is changed to the OSD type location in Sangamon County (99IL-167-008).

On page 26, delete asterisk in front of Proctor series.
