AMENDMENT NO. 4

A correlation amendment needs to be added to the "Classification and Correlation of the Soils in Fulton County, Illinois" document issued in July, 2000. These corrections are based on the evaluation of landforms and flooding frequencies throughout the MLRAs. These changes bring the Fulton County map units in line with similar map units within the MLRAs.

In the legend of Approved map unit names, beginning on page 2, change the approved names of map units as follows:

From: 37B Worthen silt loam, 2 to 5 percent slopes
To: 7037B Worthen silt loam, 2 to 5 percent slopes, rarely flooded

From: 75B Drury silt loam, 2 to 5 percent slopes
To: 7075B Drury silt loam, 2 to 5 percent slopes, rarely flooded

From: 430B Raddle silt loam, 2 to 5 percent slopes
To: 7430B Raddle silt loam, 2 to 5 percent slopes, rarely flooded

To the Conversion Legend, beginning on page 13, make appropriate changes as indicated by the above changes in publication symbols.

To the Alphabetical list of soil map units and the Numerical list of map units, beginning on page 15 and page 18, respectively, make the appropriate changes to Symbol and Map Unit Name
