GALLATIN COUNTY, ILLINOIS

AMENDMENT NO. 4

January 5, 2006

The following changes need to be made to the "Classification and Correlation of the Soils in Gallatin County, Illinois" document issued in 1966

In the legend of correlated map units:

ADD:

802 Orthents, loamy
W Water

DELETE:

271D2 Timula silt loam, 7 to 12 percent slopes, eroded
271F3 Timula silt loam, 18 to 30 percent slopes, severely eroded

The Orthents, loamy unit is added for areas that are shown on the published maps as "strip mine."

The Timula units are deleted because they were not in the original correlation, and are not delineated on the maps digitized for SSURGO certification.

"Water" is added to the list of correlated soils. Water bodies larger than about 2.5 acres are delineated on the published maps and the digitized maps for SSURGO certification. The unit was not listed in the original correlation document.
