OF THE SOILS OF MACOUPIN COUNTY, ILLINOIS
(A SUBSET OF MLRA'S 114, 115C AND 108B)
February 13, 2002**

AMENDMENT NO. 2

A correlation amendment needs to be added to the "Classification and Correlation of the Soils in Macoupin County, Illinois" document issued in August, 1999. The corrections needed are for joining with the SSURGO certified maps and data for adjacent Madison County. The additions to the correlation document are as follows:

Add to the legend of correlated soils:

Approved symbol - 119C3; and publication name - Elco silty clay loam, 5 to 10 percent slopes, severely eroded

Approved symbol - 119D3; and publication name - Elco silty clay loam, 10 to 18 percent slopes, severely eroded

Approved symbol 477D3; and publication name - Winfield silty clay loam, 10 to 18 percent slopes, severely eroded

The approved symbols above are also added to the conversion legend. The approved symbols and publication names are also added to the alphabetical legend of soil mapping units.

In the notes to accompany add the following statements:

Under ELCO add: Map unit 119C3 and 119D3 are added to the legend for joining with units in Madison County. These map units are linked to Data Map Units 156059 and 156068, respectively.

Under WINFIELD add: Map unit 477D3 is added to the legend for joining with units in Madison County. This map unit is linked to Data Map Unit 408029.
