**AMENDMENT NO. 1**


Naperville MLRA Soil Survey Project Office ran an acreage report from digital soils information of McHenry County digitized maps, a subset of MLRA 95B, and it was discovered that there were no acres of 636C2 - Parmod silt loam, 5 to 10 percent slopes, eroded mapped within McHenry County. The map unit 636C2 - Parmod silt loam, 5 to 10 percent slopes, eroded needs to be dropped from the "Classification and Correlation of Soils in McHenry, County, Illinois document." References to 636C2 occur on the following pages:

13, 26, 29, 33, 42, and 47.

An asterisk needs to be removed next to Parmod series on page 49. Two sentences needs to be removed on page 42 of Parmod series which relate to map unit 636C2. They are: "The soils in map unit 636C2 are taxadjuncts to the Parmod series as they do not have mollic epipedons. The taxadjuncts classify as fine-loamy, mixed, mesic Mollic Hapludalfs."
