AMENDMENT NO. 1

A correlation amendment needs to be added to the "Classification and Correlation of Soils in Moultrie County, Illinois" document issued in June 1999. The corrections needed are as follows:

Add the following map unit to the legend, pages 4, 10, and 11:

865 | ~~Gravel pits~~ Pits, gravel

One page 3, 618D2 approved map unit name should be spelled Senachwine

On page 8 and on the folded page of Conventional and special symbols legend, streams are not classified as perennial or intermittent. Single streams are compiled as unclassified and will not be designated as perennial or intermittent. Similarly, perennial and intermittent drainage and/or irrigation ditches will be shown as unclassified drainage and/or irrigation ditch.

On page 8, dams (medium or small) will not be shown.

On page 8 and on the folded page of Conventional and special symbols legend: soil sample sites will not be shown.

On page 17, change classification of Flanagan series from Fine, smectitic, mesic Aquertic Argiudolls to Fine, smectitic, mesic Aquic Argiudolls

On page 17, change classification of Sabina series from Fine, smectitic, mesic Aeric Chromic Vertic Epiqualfs to Fine, smectitic, mesic Aeric Epiqualfs

On page 17, change classification of Sunbury series from Fine, smectitic, mesic Aquertic Hapludalfs to Fine, smectitic, mesic Aquollic Hapludalfs
