AMENDMENT NO. 2

A correlation amendment needs to be added to the "Classification and Correlation of the Soils in Pike County, Illinois" document issued in September, 2001. The changes are needed to facilitate SSURGO re-certification, an exact join with adjacent Adams County update and to update the Pike County legend to current MLRA 115C legend. The corrections needed are as follows:

In the legend of Approved map unit names, page 2, change the approved names of map units as follows:

From: 30F Hamburg silt, 18 to 35 percent slopes
To: 30F Hamburg silt loam, 18 to 35 percent slopes

From: 30G Hamburg silt, 35 to 60 percent slopes
To: 30G Hamburg silt loam, 35 to 60 percent slopes

To the Alphabetical list of soil map units on page #20 and the Notes to accompany the classification and correlation of the soils of Pike County on page #23, make the appropriate changes to Map Unit Name.
