TECHNICAL GUIDE NOTICE IL-198

Purpose: To inform employees of changes and additions to the Field Office Technical Guide.

Background: Two hard copy technical references have been revised in the Biology and Wildlife Reference List: Endangered and Threatened Species of Illinois: Status and Distribution, Volume 1 – Plants, dated 2002, and Endangered and Threatened Species of Illinois: Status and Distribution, Volume 2 – Animals, dated 2006. The 2 hard copy references will be sent under separate cover.

The Wildlife Watering Facility standard and specification (648) has been cancelled from the National Handbook of Conservation Practices, and replaced by 614 Watering Facility. The cancelled standard and specification has been removed from the Illinois Field Office Technical Guide.

Roof Structure Certifications have been added as separate files to Waste Storage Facility (313), Composting Facility (317), and Waste Facility Cover (367); the Roof Structure Certification is no longer part of the Statement of Work (SOW).

The Roof Structure Certifications will be posted on the e-FOTG in Section IV under the respective conservation practice folder.
