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TECHNICAL GUIDE NOTICE IL - 241

Purpose: To redistribute instructions for resetting the pathway to the RUSLE 2 database.

Background: NRCS computers occasionally get replaced or undergo major repairs such as replacement of hard drives. Even though, the RUSLE 2 software has been installed or re-installed the functionality of the software gets disrupted. Often RUSLE 2 users believe their previously saved items such as profiles and local management scenarios have been lost. In most cases the items are not lost. Installing or reinstalling RUSLE 2 requires that the pathway between the computer and the RUSLE 2 database that resides on the Service Center "S" drive be reset. The attached instructions show RUSLE 2 users how to reset the pathway from a new or repaired computer to the RUSLE 2 database and restore access to RUSLE 2 saved data.

Action: Save the "Resetting the path to the RUSLE2 database file.doc" into the RUSLE 2 dedicated folder in the "S" drive for future reference. The tasks described in the instructions are only necessary on occasions where a computer is new, replaced, received a new hard drive, or any other situation that required RUSLE 2 to be loaded or re-loaded onto the computer.
