Conservation Crop Rotation (328) Practice Standard, Job Sheet, and Statement of Work.

- Updated Practice Standard, Job Sheet and Statement of Work.

Contour Buffer Strips (332) Practice Standard, Job Sheet, and Statement of Work.

- Updated Practice Standard, Job Sheet and Statement of Work.

Denitrifying Bioreactor (605) Practice Standard

- Corrected an error in the effective volume equation.

High Tunnel System (325) Practice Standard, Job Sheet, and Statement of Work.

- Practice is now established as a permanent practice and assigned a new practice code. Practice name has been changed. The number purposes for the practice were reduced to only address improved crop health and vigor.

Stripcropping (585) Practice Standard, Job Sheet, and Statement of Work.

- No significant changes. Practice standard was reviewed and revised to align with the most current version in the National Handbook of Conservation Practices.

Herbaceous Wind Barriers (603) Practice Standard, Job Sheet, and Statement of Work.

- Practice had been revised to align with the most current version in the National Handbook of Conservation Practices. Managing snow to increase available moisture and providing food and cover for wildlife are no longer purposes supported by the National Conservation Practice Standard. Reducing soil particulate emissions to improve air quality has been added as a purpose.
