TECHNICAL GUIDE NOTICE IL-37

This notice transmits actions to be taken to delete the recommended use of 2,4,5-T in Section IV of the technical guide.

Action Required

1. Delete the following from the standards and specifications for Brush Management by lining out the following:
  - a. Page 3, Item 3 - "For treatment of trees larger than 10 inches DBH, see Woodland Technical Note 1.

- b. Page 4, Table, line out headings for columns numbers 1 and 4 entitled, "Ester of 2,4,5-T<sup>2</sup>" and all entries in the in the columns below.

- c. Line out footnote<sup>2/</sup>.

2. Delete the following from the standards and specifications for Field Border by lining out the following:

On page 2 under (1) Basal spray, the second sentence, line out 2,4,5-T; or a mixture of 2,4-D and 2,4,5-T. The sentence should now read - "Apply 2,4-D in No. 1 or No. 2 fuel oil to the lower 12 inches of trunk until bark, root collar and exposed roots are thoroughly wet."

3. Make deletion in all copies of the standards and specifications for Brush Management and Field Border regardless of where they are filed.
4. All SCS personnel who have provided complete or portions of technical guides to individuals, organizations or units of government. See that the needed deletions are made in all copies of the standards and specifications for Brush Management and Field Border.
