TECHNICAL GUIDE NOTICE IL-82

This notice transmits changes in the Wildlife Food Plots Interim Standards and Specifications dated January 1988.

ACTION REQUIRED

In order to allow managers of CRP land with food plots to use seed from the Quail Unlimited programs, please make the following pen and ink changes to the Wildlife Food Plots specifications in Section IV of the Technical Guide.

Under Specifications #8 add:

9. Quail Unlimited Plot Mix 1 bag per 1/4 ac. plot

Under Specifications #9 make pen and ink changes to read:

If the plots are discontinued or relocated, the old plots will be re-established to permanent vegetation as per the rest of the field as specified in the CRP contract or a Quail Unlimited mix for reseeding food plots.
