AMENDMENT NO. 1

A correlation amendment needs to be added to the "Classification and Correlation of Soils in Will County, Illinois" document issued in March 2002. The corrections needed are as follows:

On page 7 and 41, change 688B - Braidwood silt loam, 1 to 7 percent slopes to Braidwood loam, 1 to 7 percent slopes.

On page 7 and 41, change 688D - Braidwood silt loam, 7 to 20 percent slopes to Braidwood loam, 7 to 20 percent slopes.

On page 7 and 41, change 688G - Braidwood silt loam, 20 to 70 percent slopes to Braidwood loam, 20 to 70 percent slopes.

On page 8, 19, 26 and 43, change 1082A - Millington loam, undrained, 0 to 2 percent slopes, frequently flooded to Millington silt loam, undrained, 0 to 2 percent slopes, frequently flooded.

On page 8, 19, 26 and 43, change 3082A - Millington loam, 0 to 2 percent slopes, frequently flooded to Millington silt loam, 0 to 2 percent slopes, frequently flooded.

On page 8, 19, 26 and 44, change 8082A - Millington loam, 0 to 2 percent slopes, occasionally flooded to Millington silt loam, 0 to 2 percent slopes, occasionally flooded.

On page 11 and 12, remove line feature Levee-LVS, and spot features Mine or quarry-MPI and Sandy spot-SAN from both the Conventional and Special Symbols Legend, NRCS-SOI-37A (page 11) and the Definitions and Guidelines for Use of Conventional and Special Symbols for Will County, Illinois (page 12).
