The 1990 frozen soils list is used for making highly erodible land (HEL) determinations.

¹A map unit symbol that has a number and upper case letters denotes a map unit that was brought from an adjacent county for the purpose of joining across county boundaries. Example: 001CA.

²A map unit symbol that has "MT" followed by three numbers and an upper case letter denotes a map unit join among three states in the southeast portion of Kansas. Example: MT850B.
