

Producer Self-Certification Guidance Sheet

Brush Management (314)

The following guidance is provided to assist producers with self-certifying practice completion.

- The Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) planner or Technical Service Provider (TSP) shall design the practice according to conservation practice standards and specifications and shall document information on Form KS-ECS-314, Brush Management. The same NRCS planner or TSP certifies design by signing under “Technical Service Provider.”
- Form KS-ECS-314 shall be reviewed with and concurred by the producer. The producer signs under “Producer’s Statement” that they have reviewed the practice design and agree to the species needing control and the control methods.
- Form KS-ECS-314 and Producer Self-Certification Guide Sheet shall be provided to the producer.
- Once the practice is completed, the producer completes item 7 of the Form KS-ECS-314, certifying acres completed as designed. Producer will identify treated acres on a map or aerial photo.
- Producer shall sign and date under the statement “This practice has been applied as designed.”
- Form KS-ECS-314 shall be returned to the NRCS field office along with the map or aerial photo showing the location of treated acres. No additional supporting documentation shall be required from the producer.
