


SOILS INFORMATION

INTRODUCTION

Information from the National Soils Information System (NASIS) and/or the Soil Data Mart (SDM) is used as the basis for this section. Each set of tables and soil interpretations is unique by survey area. The following listing of county folders in the e-FOTG contains electronic links to the most current versions of the soil survey data and interpretations on the Soil Data Mart. As each individual soil survey area database is updated on the Soil Data Mart, notifications will be sent to subscribers. All program eligibility applications requiring soils information that are based on frozen highly erodible land (HEL) soils data dated January 1, 1990 can be obtained from the county of interest. Conversion legends may not be available in cases where significant changes have been made to soil lines and symbols in the soil survey area after January 1, 1990.
