Earth Fruit Note: For a project area to qualify for earthfruit T&E points, the project or practices must preserve or enhance saline prairie habitat. Saline prairies are commonly characterized by a low, extensive coverage of sedges, grasses, and forbs, with few to no trees or shrubs.

La Pearlsnail Note:
 High Priority - Project area occurs directly to adjoining stream.
 Medium Priority - Project area occurs within 300 ft of stream.
 Low Priority - Project area occurs within watershed boundary.
