

Documentation of Cultural Resource Investigations

Documentation of Cultural Resources is required for all Conservation Planning conducted by NRCS. All conservation planners will follow policy as outlined in General Manual 420, Part 401 and the *NRCS National Cultural Resources Procedures Handbook Part 601*.

Cultural Resource documentation will be recorded on the Environmental Evaluation for Conservation Planning (MI-CPA-15). *If a Cultural Resource Review is necessary, a completed copy of the Request for Cultural Resources Review form with results noted by the Cultural Resources Specialist will be kept in the landowners case file.* Discovery of new Cultural Resource sites will be documented on the Historic/Archeologic New Site Report (MI-SSC-1). These forms can be located in the *Electronic Field Office Technical Guide Section, II Part C*.
