Section IV: Conservation Practices

The following documents have been entered into the Conservation Practices folder:

- 1) Anaerobic Digester-Controlled Temperature (366), Operation and Maintenance Plan, and Statement of Work. This is a new standard.
- 2) Waste Storage Facility (313) and three Operation and Maintenance Plans. This is an updated standard. See vertical bars in the standard.
