MISSOURI TECHNICAL GUIDE TRANSMITTAL NO. 384

This transmittal is to make the field aware of new and existing economic tools in the Missouri eFOTG.

In Section I under Economic Data, Other Resources, new cost tools can be found. The new tools in this section are: a Partial Budgeting form, outline for Conservation Effects for Decision-makers, and a workbook called Interest, Annuities and Amortization.

In Section V of the eFOTG there is a new excel file called Conservation Practice Economic Effects (CPEE). This tool can be used to see the expected effects on land, capitol, labor, management level, risk, and profitability of a conservation practice.

To use this tool, go to Section V, Conservation Practice Economic Effects and then over to the file called CPEE, double click to open the file. When the file opens type the practice code of the practice you wish to evaluate and press enter. All information about that practice will come up. You may have to scroll down and/or over to see the entire sheet. There is a button labeled "go to terminology" on the right side of your screen. Clicking this button will take you to the definitions of the evaluation categories. To return to the main form click the button labeled "back" on the worksheets top right side.
