MISSOURI TECHNICAL GUIDE TRANSMITTAL NO. 402

The following revised Missouri conservation practice standards and specifications have been posted on the Missouri eFOTG:

*Grade Stabilization Structure (410)*

Changes to the Design Criteria for Side-Inlet Drainage Structures have been made. Side-inlet structures are used extensively in Southeast Missouri and the changes are intended to meet the requirements of the unique landscapes, drainage systems and farming practices of the region.

*Watering Facility (614)*

Watering Facility is the new name of the 614 practice standard that was previously named Trough or Tank in the Missouri FOTG. The wording and organization of the body of the standard has been changed to follow that of the National Standard. No substantial changes have been made to the technical content of the standard.
