*Controlling Undesirable Trees and Shrubs (IS-MO666cut)*  
*Feed Management (592)*

The Information Sheets are located in Section IV, under the related Conservation Practice. Field offices should use these information sheets with land users that have extended questions dealing with the related subject matter.

The Feed Management (592) standard deals with managing the quantity of available nutrients fed to livestock and poultry for their intended purpose. This standard can be included as a component practice for Comprehensive Nutrient Management Planning. It is a new state and national standard.

This transmittal also notes an updated "Cultural Resources Ground Disturbing Potential for Conservation Practices" list that is now posted on the Missouri eFOTG. This material is located in Section II, under Cultural Resources Information.
