Updated to incorporate revisions in the national standard and specify hydromulching as an acceptable method.

**Residue and Tillage Management No Till / Strip Till / Direct Seed (329):**

The following changes have been made to page 1 of this standard under  
CONDITIONS WHERE PRACTICE APPLIES:

“Approved implements are no-till and strip-till planters; certain drills and air seeders; strip-type fertilizer and manure injectors and applicators; in-row chisels; and similar implements that only disturb strips and slots. All others are considered to be full-width or capable of full width disturbance and therefore not compatible.”
