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MISSOURI TECHNICAL GUIDE TRANSMITTAL NO. 445

The following Missouri conservation practice standards, statements of work (SOW), agronomy specification and cultivars information sheet have been posted on the Missouri eFOTG:

Waste Storage Facility (313) - Standard

This revised standard now has criteria requiring the minimum slab on grade thickness for liquid-tight applications with uniform foundations to be 5 inches without exception. This is the only change to the standard.

Comprehensive Nutrient Management Plan - Statement of Work

The revised Statement of Work clarifies the responsibility of the planner to describe the application and/or export activities for all manure/wastewater produced by an animal operation. This is the only change to the Statement of Work.
