The following Missouri conservation practice Job Sheet and Information Sheet have been posted on the Missouri FOTG:

The Nutrient Management Job Sheet has minor word editing and a checklist that match the September 2007 version of the Nutrient Management (590) conservation practice standard and statement of work. The content is largely unchanged from the previous (1999) version.

The Nutrient Management (590) Documentation Information Sheet outlines recommended methods for documenting nutrient management portions of conservation plans that meet the requirements of the nutrient management conservation practice standard.

The conservation information sheet on Phosphorus Fertilizer Management summarizes guidelines for applications of monoammonium phosphate (MAP) and diammonium phosphate (DAP) fertilizer products and acceptable alternatives for establishing seedings. These phosphorus fertilizer products contain incidental amounts of nitrogen, and care must be taken to limit the amount of nitrogen applied with some seeding mixtures. This information sheet supports the Vegetation Establishment, Herbaceous Seeding (723) Specification.
