MISSOURI TECHNICAL GUIDE TRANSMITTAL NO. 454

The Threatened and Endangered (T&E) Species Best Management Practices (BMP) have now been posted on the eFOTG. These can be found in "Section II, F., T&E Species, 3. Conservation planning guidance". These were previously located on the T drive.

The Bald Eagle BMP has also been added to this list of T&E BMP's. The Bald Eagle BMP has been revised to reflect Eagle's delisting from the federal and state endangered species list in Missouri. Bald Eagles continue to be protected by the federal Bald and Golden Eagle Protection Act of 1940. The Bald Eagle remains on the Missouri Species of Conservation Concern Checklist with a State Rank of S3 (Vulnerable), and therefore, must continue to be evaluated on the CPA-52. The Missouri Department of Conservation prepared this, and the other species BMP's, to provide guidance for staff to utilize and interpret the T & E matrix.
