MISSOURI TECHNICAL GUIDE TRANSMITTAL NO. 463

The following Missouri conservation practice standards, construction specifications, operation and maintenance guides and statements of work (SOW) have been posted on the Missouri eFOTG:

- *Closure of Waste Impoundments (360): Standard and SOW*
Definition was revised from “waste storage ponds” to “liquid storage facility” in response to revisions of the national standards to accommodate fabricated structures. Demolition of Fabricated Structures was added in response to revisions of the national standard and to address the situation where fabricated structures are used for a component in a waste management system. A typical fabricated structure would be a concrete tank. Emphasis has been placed on odor control/minimization during the closure procedure.
- *Irrigation Regulation Reservoir (552): Standard and SOW*
No major changes have been made.
