The following Missouri Conservation Practice Standards, Specifications, Operation and Maintenance (O&M) and Statements of Work (SOW) have been posted on the Missouri Field Office Technical Guide under Section IV:

Clearing and Snagging (326): Practice Standard, Specification, O&M and SOW
Edited to match latest national standard, no major changes.

Sediment Basin (350): Practice Standard, Specification, O&M and SOW
Considerable edits were made to match latest national standard. Standard now contains minimum sediment storage volume amounts.

Diversions (362): Practice Standard, Specification, O&M and SOW
Edited to match latest national standard, no major changes.

Grassed Waterway (412): Practice Standard, Specification, O&M and SOW
Edited to match latest national standard, no major changes. Added guidance for minimum design velocity of 1.5 feet per second to limit sediment deposition.

Access Road (560): Practice Standard, Specification, O&M and SOW
Edited to match latest national standard, no major changes.

Heavy Use Area Protection (561): Practice Standard, Specification, O&M and SOW
Considerable changes have been made to Table 1, "Typical Surface Material Installation Conditions". The construction specifications and O&M plan are new.

Spoil Spreading (572): Practice Standard, Specification, O&M and SOW
Edited to match latest national standard, no major changes.
