MISSOURI TECHNICAL GUIDE TRANSMITTAL NO. 510

The following Missouri Conservation Practice Standards and Statements of Work (SOW) have been posted on the Missouri Field Office Technical Guide under Section IV:

- *Pond Sealing or Lining – Flexible Membrane (521A): Standard* – This state revision incorporates the content of the national standard dated September 2011.
- *Pond Sealing or Lining – Soil Dispersant Treatment (521B): Standard* – This state revision incorporates the content of the national standard dated September 2010. The revision includes state regulatory requirements for waste impoundments.
- *Pond Sealing or Lining – Bentonite Treatment (521C): Standard* - This state revision incorporates the content of the national standard dated September 2010. The revision includes state regulatory requirements for waste impoundments.
- *Pond Sealing or Lining – Compacted Clay Treatment (521D): Standard* – This is a new conservation practice standard in Missouri. The main application is to utilize borrow material when insitu material is not acceptable for construction of a pond or waste impoundment.
- *Pond Sealing or Lining (521A,B,C and D) Statement of Work* – The statement of work was revised in order for it to be applicable for all of the 521 conservation practice standards.
- *Water Well (642): Standard and Statement of Work* – The revision incorporates the changes in the national standard and also includes state specific requirements. The SOW is specific that a copy of the well certification is a deliverable for Check-Out.
