The following Water Quality Monitoring Activities have been posted on the Missouri Field Office Technical Guide under Section I > Water Quality Monitoring Activities:

- ***EDGE-OF-FIELD Water Quality Monitoring Data Collection and Evaluation Conservation Activity (Code 201):*** Water quality monitoring and evaluation under this conservation activity standard are the actions and activities, using acceptable tools and protocols, by which a producer will measure the effectiveness of conservation practices and systems. Evaluation of conservation practice effectiveness through edge-of-field monitoring will lead to a better understanding of constituent loading and will assist NRCS and participants in adapting or validating the application of conservation measures.
- ***EDGE-OF-FIELD Water Quality Monitoring System Installation Conservation Activity (Code 202):*** This conservation activity standard addresses the system installation associated with edge-of-field water quality monitoring.
