MISSOURI TECHNICAL GUIDE TRANSMITTAL NO. 524

The following Missouri Conservation Practice Standards, Statements of Work (SOW) and Jobsheets have been posted on the Missouri Field Office Technical Guide under Section IV > Conservation Practices:

- *Windbreak/Shelterbelt Establishment (380): Standard and SOW* – This state revision incorporates the content of the national standard revisions, including the addition of the term “pollinator” to the wildlife planning consideration that discusses species diversity and the addition of a new Purpose of “Reduce Energy Use” and the accompanying additional Criteria.
- *Riparian Forest Buffer (391): Standard and SOW* – This state revision incorporates the content of the national standard revisions, including the addition of the term “pollinator” to additional criteria to create or improve riparian habitat.
- *Tree/Shrub Establishment (612): Standard, SOW, and Job Sheets* – This state revision incorporates the content of the national standard revisions, including the addition of the term “pollinator” to the wildlife planning consideration and the addition of new Purposes of “Reduce Energy Use” and “Develop Renewable Energy Systems” and the accompanying additional Criteria for each. Other technical additions were included throughout the practice standard. The Job Sheets were also updated to reflect all changes.
