MARYLAND TECHNICAL GUIDE

CHANGE NOTICE NO. 65

Purpose. To distribute three new conservation practice standards, two updated standards, and one new technical note. A revised List of Conservation Practices and a Change Notice Register are also attached.

Effective Date. Upon receipt.

Explanation. The following Maryland conservation practice standards are issued as final:

- **Fish Passage (Code 396)**
- **Nutrient Management (Code 590)**
- **Prescribed Forestry (Code 409)**
- **Stream Habitat Improvement and Management (Code 395)**
- **Use Exclusion (Code 472)**

The following Maryland Plant Materials Technical Note is issued:

- **Windbreak Plant Species for Odor Management around Poultry Production Facilities**

Filing Instructions.

Section I:

- File this Change Notice and the new Change Notice Register in the front of Section I of the Field Office Technical Guide. Discard the old Change Notice Register.

Section IV-A:

- File the revised List of Conservation Practice Standards in the front of Section IV-Practice Standards of the Field Office Technical Guide. Discard the old list.
- Remove and discard the old standards for Codes 472 and 590.
- File the new standards for Codes 395, 396, 409, 472, and 590 in Section IV.
- File the new Technical Note for windbreaks behind the conservation practice standard for Windbreak/Shelterbelt (Code 380).
