MARYLAND TECHNICAL GUIDE

CHANGE NOTICE NO. 66

Purpose. To add a reference document in Section I, distribute conservation practice standards and a jobsheet in Section IV, and update the Conservation Practices Physical Effects (CPPE) table in Section V. A revised List of Conservation Practices and the Change Notice Register have also been updated.

Effective Date. Upon receipt.

Explanation. Section I: The document "DE-MD Wetland Mapping Conventions for Agricultural Lands" has been added to the References section.

Section IV: The following Maryland conservation practice standards are issued as final:

- **Forest Stand Improvement (Code 666);**
- **Manure Transfer (Code 634);**
- **Residue and Tillage Management, No-Till/Strip-Till/Direct-Seed (Code 329);**
- **Residue and Tillage Management, Mulch-Till (Code 345);**
- **Streambank and Shoreline Protection (Code 580);**
- **Windbreak/Shelterbelt Establishment (Code 380).**

The following Maryland job sheet is issued as final:

- **Windbreaks for Poultry Houses.**

Section V: The Conservation Practices Physical Effects (CPPE) table has been updated.

Instructions.

Section I:

- File this Change Notice and the Change Notice Register (updated pages xv-xvi) in the front of Section I of the Field Office Technical Guide. Discard the last page of the previous Change Notice Register.

Section IV-A:

- File the revised List of Conservation Practice Standards in the front of Section IV-Practice Standards. Discard the old list.
- Remove and discard the old standards for Codes 329, 345, 380, 580, and 666.
- File the revised standards for Codes 329, 345, 380, 580, and 666 in Section IV.
- File the new standard for Code 634 in Section IV.
- File the revised job sheet for poultry windbreaks behind the conservation practice standard for Windbreak/Shelterbelt (Code 380).
