MARYLAND TECHNICAL GUIDE

CHANGE NOTICE NO. 67

Purpose. To distribute conservation practice standards in Section IV. A revised List of Conservation Practices and the Change Notice Register have also been updated.

Effective Date. Upon receipt.

Explanation. Section IV: The following Maryland conservation practice standards are issued as final:

- **Amendments for Treatment of Agricultural Waste (Code 591);**
- **Animal Mortality Facility (Code 316);**
- **Composting Facility (Code 317);**
- **Irrigation Water Conveyance, High-Pressure, Underground, Plastic Pipeline (Code 430DD);**
- **Pond Sealing or Lining, Compacted Clay Treatment (Code 521D);**
- **Spring Development (Code 574);**
- **Structure For Water Control (Code 587);**
- **Surface Drainage, Field Ditch (Code 607);**
- **Waste Storage Facility (Code 313);**
- **Watering Facility (Code 614).**

Filing Instructions. Section I:

- File this Change Notice and the Change Notice Register (updated page xvii) in the front of Section I of the Field Office Technical Guide.

Section IV-A:

- File the revised List of Conservation Practice Standards in the front of Section IV-Practice Standards. Discard the old list.
- Remove and discard the old standards for Codes 317, 574, 587, 607, 313, and 614.
- File the revised standards for Codes 317, 574, 587, 607, 313, and 614 in Section IV.
- File the new standards for Codes 591, 316, 430DD, and 521D in Section IV.
