MARYLAND TECHNICAL GUIDE

CHANGE NOTICE NO. 68

Purpose. To distribute conservation practice standards in Section IV. A revised List of Conservation Practices and the Change Notice Register have also been updated.

Effective Date. Upon receipt.

Explanation. Section IV: The following Maryland conservation practice standards are issued as final:

- **Agrichemical Handling Facility (Code 309)** – formerly Agrichemical Mixing Facility (Code 702);
- **Early Successional Habitat Development/Management (Code 647);**
- **Field Border (Code 386);**
- **Heavy Use Area Protection (Code 561);**
- **Tree/Shrub Establishment (Code 612).**

Filing Instructions. Section I:

- File this Change Notice and the Change Notice Register (updated page xvii) in the front of Section I of the Field Office Technical Guide.

- Section IV-A:
- File the revised List of Conservation Practice Standards in the front of Section IV-Practice Standards. Discard the old list.
 - Remove and discard the old standards for Codes 386, 561, 612, and 702.
 - File the new standards for Codes 309, 386, 561, 612, and 647 in Section IV.
