MARYLAND TECHNICAL GUIDE

CHANGE NOTICE NO. 57

Purpose. To distribute one revised and two new conservation practice standards, plus related checklists and standard drawings. One interim standard is cancelled. A revised List of Conservation Practices and a Change Notice Register is also attached.

Effective Date. Upon receipt.

Explanation. The following Maryland conservation practice standards are issued as final:

- Fence, Code 382;
- Forage Harvest Management, Code 511;
- Pest Management, Code 595.

The following Maryland Practice Implementation Checklists are issued as final:

- MD-RES-382;
- MD-RES-511;
- MD-RES-595.

The following Maryland Standard Drawings for Fence (Code 382) are issued as final:

- 382-A1 through A4;
- 382-B1 through B4;
- 382-C;
- 382-D1 through D7;
- 382-E;
- 382-F;
- 382-G.

The following Maryland interim standard (guideline) is cancelled:

- Record Keeping, Code 991-G.

Filing Instructions.

Section I:

- File this Change Notice and the new Change Notice Register in the front of Section I of the Field Office Technical Guide. Discard the old Change Notice Register.

Section IV:

- File the new List of Conservation Practice Standards in the front of Section IV- Practice Standards of the Field Office Technical Guide. Discard the old list.

- File the new standards, checklists, and drawings for Codes 382, 511, and 595 in Section IV.
- Remove the old standard for Code 382 and the cancelled standard for Code 991-G, and file them in Section IV-Archived Practices.

Distribution. One copy of each standard is being sent to each office. These standards, checklists, and standard drawings will be posted on the Internet at the following address:
