Firebreaks are temporary or permanent gaps in vegetation or combustible material that acts as a barrier to help protect an area from wildfire or to contain/exclude a prescribed burn. Firebreaks are usually bare ground, fire-resistant vegetation or a combination of these. Where possible, firebreaks should tie into existing physical barriers such as highways, roads, rivers, streams, logging trails, etc. Raking and other hand work may be required to temporarily tie permanent firebreaks into streams, wetlands and other sensitive areas.
