### Conservation Cover – 327

Conservation Cover Plantings – 327 shall be planned and applied in accordance with the Standard detailed in Field Office Technical Guide (FOTG) – Section IV – Conservation Practices. This document provides conservation planners with additional parameters, recommendations, references, and requirements for developing site-specific plans for this practice.
