Deliverables:

Plan shall use the templates on the North Dakota Engineering Website or at a minimum contain all the information in the templates. Templates shall be modified to the specific site and include project specific information, maps, data.
3. Certification that the Plan meets practice standard criteria and complies with applicable laws and regulations.

INSTALLATION

1. Pre-implementation conference with client.
2. Verification that client has obtained required permits (if applicable).
3. Implementation guidance as needed.
4. Facilitate and implement required design modifications with client and original developer of the IWM Plan.
5. Advise client/NRCS on compliance issues with all federal, state, tribal and local laws, regulations and NRCS policies during implementation.

1. Records of implementation: extent of practice units applied
